Durango Brewing Company

Durango Brewing Company is Colorado's third oldest microbrewery, brewing great beer since 1990. The company, and brewing legacy, began originally as Durango Beer and Ice Company in 1887 and about a year later became Durango Brewing Company. While operations were not continuous, the goal of producing great tasting, quality fresh beer remains. In those early years, Durango Brewing Company supplied beer to the mining camps of Southwest Colorado and to the nearby towns of Silverton, Rico, and Dolores. It was not uncommon to see Durango kegs being shipped on the train to Silverton, CO.

A new tap room opened at Durango Brewing in November 2007. It is a railroad themed room and bar, with a "grill your own" kitchen featuring burgers and brats from a local ranch.

Durango Wheat Beer

Using water born from high in the San Juan Mountains, D-Wheat (local name) is an American-Style Wheat with domestic barley and wheat malts. It's gold in color and has a moderate body, yet a crisp, full flavor.

Durango Amber Ale

An American-Style Amber Ale brewed with both domestic and imported malts. It has deep amber color, medium body, and mild hop bitterness making it a well balanced refreshing beer.

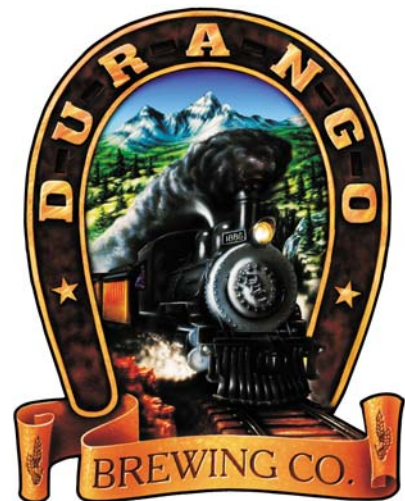
2005 International Beer Festival Silver Medal Winner
